As the nation prepares to elect its future leaders, the RSL has called upon all candidates to demonstrate a shared dedication to our veterans by committing support to five key priorities:

- An enduring commitment to implement in full the recommendations of the Royal Commission into Defence and Veteran Suicide
- Improved access to quality fee-free advocacy
- Improved access to healthcare for veterans and their families
- Sustained investment in the Department of Veterans' Affairs
- Boost Australia's Defence Capability through investment in a 'balanced force'
